Day 01 AUSTRALIA TO HONG KONG

Day 03 HONG KONG – DISNEYLAND MAIN STREET PARADE PERFORMANCE

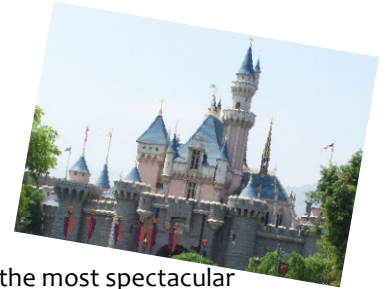
